

Five in a Row

Objectives: ...draw on experience to bring meanings to words in context such as figurative language
...study word meanings systematically such as across curricular content areas
... acquire an extensive vocabulary through reading and systematic word study

Play this vocabulary game with a partner. Write a vocabulary word in each square. Each player has markers of ONE color. Take turns playing by putting down a marker on a square, saying the word, and giving a meaning or using it in a sentence. If correct in **meaning** and **pronunciation**, the player gets to stay on the square. **The first person to get five in a row wins.** You may not use diagonals unless both players agree to it.
